PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Season 95-96 saw a marked improvement I feel will be the start of an upward surge in the Club's performances on and off the field.

The team performances were, I think, what we expected. The makeup of the 1st Grade side indicated that we would be hard pressed to make the semis in a team with very little experience playing in a competition where the standard has improved rapidly. However the younger players in this side learned a lot and acquitted themselves well.

The 2nd's had a mixed season, starting off very slowly but coming with a surge after Christmas and a chance of making the four. This did not eventuate but I think they surprised a lot of people with their performances. History was made with Hat Tricks in the same match.....Congratulations to Mark Koszek and Brad Stone!

Our success story was of course Michael Wood's 3rd Grade, our first premiership since 89-90. Again we believed at the start of the season that our two lower grades would fare well. The team was never out of the four during the season and continually improved to such an extent that they easily beat their opponents in both the Semi and Final, winning the Semi by 10 wickets and followed up with an outright in the Final by an innings....A tremendous effort and hearty congratulations to all.

Another team to start the season in top form, the 4's were leading the competition just prior to Christmas, but were then hit with our "perennial problem" - unavailability. How is a Club to perform when 10 or 11 players become unavailable for 2 consecutive rounds? Skipper Paul Bucholtz did a magnificent job to organise his team through these difficult times with so many changes and youngsters having their first year. There were some very creditable performances in this team.

On the subject of performances the Club is pleasingly up for more trophies this year....Three Hat Tricks (two in 2nd Grade and 1 in 4th Grade), six centuries and three 7 for's. We have never had this many outstanding performances in one season....Let's make it more next year.

Our finances are in reasonable shape, thanks mainly to Paul Bucholtz who did a terrific job in arranging sponsorship money and we sincerely hope this continues. We need to tighten up in a few areas if we are to maintain our fees at the same level. I am sure you are aware it is extremely difficult running and maintaining a Club such as ours, with few members and very limited resources......We all need to "put in", not just the usual few.

I believe our coach for the last three years, Matt Troy, is "hanging up his boots". This will disappoint most of us, but we respect Matt's decision and hope he will continue to be involved with the Club. Matt, a sincere thank you, for your contribution, on behalf of all the Club.

Our seasonal English imports continued in 95-96, this time being Nick Heale, who performed creditably in the Firsts and Under 24's. Nick fitted in extremely well and was very popular. Hope to see you in Oz again Nick...best wishes from all of us. Thanks also to Ingrid and Daniel Burton for accommodation and to all those others that <u>looked after Nick</u>.

Mona Park continues to be one of the best complexes in Sydney Cricket and we greatly appreciate the support of Auburn Council and their staff for their efforts and contribution. We had a problem with the main wicket during the season with collapsed drainage pipes under the wicket square, however we believe this will be rectified at the start of next season when the square is to be relaid and hopefully enlarged.

On the subject of thanks, the following deserve special mention:

Paul Bucholtz: For his fundraising efforts and his lovely wife Julie who was always by his side assisting.

Bob Hadley: Who organised practice facilities weekly, plus laying down the covers on countless occasions. Bob also contributed greatly to the day to day running of the Club.

Greg Ryan: For organising the "Auburn Open" golf day which was well supported. Well done, Greg.

Ron Eager: For his continued and much appreciated assistance in training, coaching and general advice.

Ted Suchy: Who maintains our records. Ted has done a magnificent job with our "stats", plus we appreciate his continued financial assistance.

Gerry Kenny: And son Andrew for their contribution to the stocking and manning of the canteen.

Anthony Donaldson: Parks and Gardens Supervisor (Auburn District Council), and his ground staff....Grant and Graham.....Your efforts for the sport of cricket are sincerely appreciated.

To all those players and ex-players who "put in" at The Lakes Golf Club. Unfortunately we had more ex-players than current members turn up.

Last, but not least, to **Michael Wood**, who continues to do a most professional job as Secretary. We appreciate his total commitment to the running of the Club.

Congratulations to the trophy winners - it is good to see so many of the younger players picking up the accolades.

Finally, thanks to the Committee for their involvement and to the players as a whole for the manner in which they represented the Auburn Club. Things are looking good for the future and let's <u>all</u> contribute to ensure success.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

1995 / 96 SAW AUBURN RETURN TO THE WINNER'S LIST BY TAKING OUT THE 3RD GRADE PREMIERSHIP FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 1986 / 87. THE 3RD GRADE SIDE PERFORMED WELL ALL YEAR AND ARE WORTHY PREMIERS.

WHILST THE OTHER THREE SIDES DID NOT MAKE THE SEMI-FINALS, 4TH GRADE WERE WELL IN CONTENTION FOR A LARGE PART OF THE SEASON UNTIL UNAVAILABILITY OF PLAYERS IN THE HIGHER GRADES TOOK ITS TOLL ON THE BALANCE OF THE 4TH GRADE SIDE.

NONETHELESS, THERE WERE A NUMBER OF PROMISING SIGNS FOR NEXT SEASON WITH SOME VERY TALENTED PLAYERS IN THE LOWER GRADES PUSHING FOR HIGHER HONOURS, AS WELL AS THE CALIBRE OF PLAYERS LIKE ROBIN LOPEZ, PAUL GEFTAKIS, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF JASON COOK AND MARK MITCHELL IN THE 1ST GRADE SIDE THIS SEASON.

ONE DISAPPOINTING ASPECT OF THE SEASON WAS ONCE AGAIN THE DROP OFF IN ATTENDANCE AT PRACTICE AFTER CHRISTMAS. IT SEEMS THAT A LOT OF PLAYERS ARE OF THE VIEW THAT THEY DO NOT NEED TO PRACTICE AFTER CHRISTMAS, HOWEVER, THEIR PERFORMANCES DID NOT JUSTIFY THIS THEORY.

IT WAS ALSO DISAPPOINTING TO HAVE PLAYERS REGULARLY PULL OUT OF MATCHES, ESPECIALLY IN FIRST AND 2ND GRADE. WHILST THIS WAS NOT AS BAD AS IN PREVIOUS YEARS, IT IS STILL AN AREA OF CONCERN, AS IT NOT ONLY AFFECTS THE TEAM THEY ARE IN BUT ALSO ADVERSELY AFFECTS ALL THE GRADES BELOW THEM.

SPECIAL THANKS MUST BE GIVEN TO PAUL BUCHOLTZ FOR HIS GREAT EFFORT IN OBTAINING SPONSORS, KEVIN CARR FOR HIS WILLINGNESS TO HELP IN ANY CAPACITY, AND TED SUCHY FOR HIS TIRELESS WORK IN MAINTAINING THE CLUB'S STATISTICS AND THE PRODUCTION OF THE ANNUAL REPORT.

WHILST THEIR WERE SOME PROBLEMS WITH THE WICKET SQUARE TIS SEASON ON MONA PARK 1, IT DOES NOT TAKE AWAY FROM THE HARD WORK PUT IN BY THE GROUND STAFF, GRAHAM WILSON AND GRANT BERENGER UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND DIRECTION OF PARKS AND GARDENS SUPERVISOR, ANTHONY DONALDSON. THANKS FOR YOUR TIME AND EFFORT FELLAS.

THE CLUB CONTINUES TO ENJOY A GOOD RAPPORT WITH THE AUBURN COUNCIL WHICH HAS ONCE AGAIN BEEN VERY SUPPORTIVE OF THE CLUB, FOR WHICH WE ARE GREATLY APPRECIATIVE AND LOOK TO MAINTAIN IN THE FUTURE.

FIRST GRADE CAPTAIN'S REPORT

During the 1994-95 season 19 players gained selection in the First Grade side. The final results of the fifteen matches were:

- * 3 first innings wins
- * 1 draw
- * 1 wash out
- * 7 first innings losses
- * 3 outright losses

This placed the side on 18 points and in 15th place on the final points table.

These results and our second last placing are very disappointing both personally for all the players in the side and for our Club. However, all year there was a strong spirit and unity amongst the players that kept the team together and always striving to perform well on what has to be stated as a very poor Mona Park 1st Grade wicket.

Rarely did the 1st Grade side score in excess of 200 runs. On the 4 occasions we did, we won 3 of the games and drew the fourth. This showing that our inability as a team to score decent totals was a major reason for the disappointing results of the season.

The bowling attack mostly found success and were able to capture wickets. It was after lamented, that with just 20 or 30 more runs from our batting how close we might have come to winning 6 or 7 more games.

In brief, the season's wins were against Pennant Hills, Roseville and Bexley. Some of the magic moments of the season included:

- * Glen Mitchell capturing the first wicket of the season on just the third ball of the season against Blacktown.

- * Marc Rouillon's gutsy and inspirational 31 against Bexley in a partnership of 79 runs. In his only 1st Grade appearance for the season he was elevated by the adoring crowd to Bradman status.
- * Glen Mitchell capturing the last wicket of the season against Bexley to secure a first innings win for the 1st Grade side. Glen finished the match with the strong figures of 5/55 off 21.3 overs.

SECOND GRADE CAPTAIN'S REPORT

The 1995/96 season for second grade was one of mixed fortunes. Our record of five wins, eight losses and two draws and an outright tie leaving us in 10th position. This is not a true reflection of the talent of the team. We did have trouble keeping good players and getting suitable replacements on the field. One thing that pleased me the most was when a game was in a tight situation, we kept our composure, putting the pressure on our opponents and not on us. The result was we came away with first innings points on three occasions by a margin no greater than three runs.

Bowling was our strength throughout the season enabling us to bowl out teams consistently for around 200. Our downfall was the inability to score enough runs. This was one of the most exciting games of cricket I have ever been involved in and I am sure all the guys would agree. After a solid start at 0/55 Auburn collapsed to be all out for 99. Strathfield were on the ropes with a Hat Trick to opening bowler Mark Koszek (20-4-34-4) and overnight reached 6/68. Strathfield toiled on day two to 8/96 when they lost their last two wickets. We gave Strathfield a difficult target of 120 from around 15 overs and through yet another hat trick this time to Brad Stone (1.4-0-3-5) we crushed Strathfield for 83. Mark and Brad finishing with match figures of 8/68 and 6/34 respectively.

Our best batting performance was against South East Sydney at Mona 2. Chasing 280 we passed the total with the loss of only 3 wickets. The performers were Hopper 56, Ryan 48, Willoughby 35, Rugless 60* and Richardson 40*. An excellent team effort. Other batting highlights were 61* from Wes Saunders who blasted Burwood, Mark Mitchell's 52* against Epping and Mark Koszek 49* (he says he was left stranded) left with no batsmen as he ran Brad Stone out hitting a ball straight to cover..

Bowling was led by Mark Koszek, who bowled with pace and venom at times, and Brad Stone who bowled at times without luck but managed to take control, contain and frustrate many a batsmen. Congrats to both bowlers with 23 wickets each. Good support from Richardson (14) and Rugless (14) and the surprise packet Clinton Daley, our wicket keeper, collecting seven wickets in the last two games. Where has he been hiding?

Overall our fielding was good and our catching was brilliant at times but mainly solid. Our slips catching was not up to speed so lets sharpening up those reflexes.

I would like to thank all the players for their support through the season, and start training now for the new season so we can be a force in the next competition. We have the talent, lets work hard to make sure we perform where it counts.....on the field.

Usually the most consistent batsmen Danny would be the first to admit he had a tough season. Danny was not helped by coming in after many mini collapses which placed added pressure on him.
